THE JACKDAW HISTORY

The Jackdaw is a Grade 2 listed building built in 1645, in the 19th year of the reign of King Charles I. This was originally a farmhouse belonging to the estate of Thomas Leythorne and up until 1756 was leased out to tenant farmers. In 1756, under the ownership of Keeble Estate, Andrew Snell Esq. took lease and was given a licence to sell Ales and Ciders, these premises were then subsequently named 'The Red Lion'. In 1962 the name was changed to 'The Jackdaw' as the then brewery owners, considered there to be too many other pubs in the area with the same name.

There are two claims to fame for The Jackdaw. First, how it got it's new name. During the 1760's the celebrated poet Thomas Grey was a regular patron, as was Richard Harris Barham: a local resident who lived in the village of Denton and compiled the famous "Ingoldsby Legends- The Jackdaw Of Rheims". So it was in 1962 in honour of that poet The Jackdaw's name came to be. Secondly, The Jackdaw was featured in the epic film "The Battle Of Britain", starring Michael Caine and Christopher Plummer. "The Battle of Britain," and the famous air-battle was fought in the skies over this pub. The Jackdaw showcases a variety of Spitfire memorabilia, especially in the Spitfire room.
